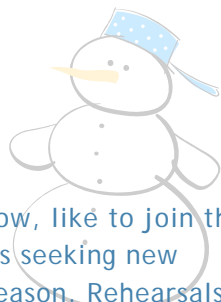




JOIN THE GEM CITY JAZZ ENSEMBLE FOR SUNDAY FUNDAYS AT THE LIBRARY

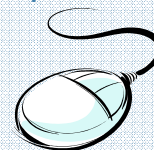
